

Q3 Do you have a share in the ownership of your organisation (e.g. equity partner, shareholder)?





**Q4** Do you have responsibility for supervising or managing the work of lawyers or other employees?





# **Q5** From the list of age bands below, please indicate the category that includes your current age in years:





#### **Q6** What is your gender?








# Q9 What is your ethnic group?



**Q10** If you went to University (to study a BA, BSc course or higher),were you part of the first generation of your family to do so?





# Q11 Did you mainly attend a state or fee paying school between the ages 11 – 18?




